What is a Title I School?

Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Act of 1965 is amended to read as follows:

Title I-Improving the academic achievement of the disadvantaged.

The purpose of Title I is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.

Title I School-Wide Program

- The purpose of school-wide Title I programs is to improve the entire educational program in a school which should result in improving the academic achievement of all students, particularly the lowest achieving students. The goal of such a program is to assist those students to demonstrate proficiency on academic standard.
- ► A school-wide program must include the following components:
- School-wide reform strategies
- Instruction by highly qualified teachers
- Parental involvement
- Additional support for students if needed
 - Read 180 and System 44
 - Do the Math
 - Reading Mastery
